Dear Parents/Carers

There is just over five school weeks before Year 5/6 travel to Tea Gardens for their excursion at the Great Aussie Bush Camp and this will most probably be the last correspondence sent home.

The total cost for the Great Aussie Bush Camp has been confirmed at \$365 per student. All students who have returned their Expression of Interest note and paid their deposit have now been invoiced for the balance of the excursion.

Students need to have paid their final payment on or before 12<sup>th</sup> May 2014 unless prior arrangements have been made.

As I'm sure you're aware in the case of overnight excursions there are requirements by law that all forms be completed and returned before departure. Some forms have similar or same information but must be completed all the same.

The following information regards departure and return times, a gear check list and some basic guidelines we have set for the excursion:

- Departure time: 8.00am, Monday 19<sup>th</sup> May 2014 from Uralla Central School bus bay.
- Return time: 3.00pm Thursday 22<sup>th</sup> May 2014 to Uralla Central School bus bay.
- Travel will be by bus with McPhersons Buses of Walcha.
- Students are *not permitted* to bring mobile phones on the excursion. If a student for some reason needs to contact home, this will be accommodated by teachers. In case of emergency students can be contacted on the school's mobile, 0400 405 600.
- Students will stay in cabins, each cabin accommodates 4-6 students and cabin groups will be organised by a teacher closer to the excursion date.
- Students will need to bring a packed lunch and morning tea for Monday.
- Please ensure students have warm bedding as it does get extremely cold of a night and it is better to have too much bedding rather than not enough.
- Students exhibiting poor behaviour leading up to the camp may be withdrawn from the excursion.
